A FAST can be requested in the event of a disaster to deploy to a shelter to conduct assessments of shelter residents who have disabilities and/or access and functional needs. FAST members must be willing and able to work under stressful conditions for long hours. FAST members help to develop and implement reasonable accommodations, and generate resource requests for equipment that will allow shelter residents with disabilities and/or access and functional needs to remain in a general population shelter. These resources may include durable medical equipment, consumable medical supplies, prescribed medications or a person to assist with activities of daily living.</p> <p>FAST members must possess the knowledge, skills, and abilities to work in their area of specialty, as well as a minimum of two years' experience working with and assessing the needs of people with disabilities and/or access and functional needs.</p> <p>There is no cost for this course; however, seating is limited.
