The S-404 Safety Officer course curriculum will deliver “all risk” emergency response and operational training. Included in the training will be hazard assessment, operational responsibilities and accident investigation requirements. Special topics include; developing and presenting safety messages, utilization of forms and tools, use of assistant safety officers for incidents including technical rescue and hazmat. Students will utilize real case studies and events that have occurred throughout the United States.

This is a four-day class (24hrs) and a must for all fire service members. Students are required to attend all four days. Upon completion, the student will receive a **California State Fire Training Certificate**.
