FIRE 105 FIREFIGHTER 1 ACADEMY

17 UNITS

This course provides students with the State Fire Marshal's Office educational requirements for certification as a Firefighter 1.

Prerequisites, EMMS 170; Biddle CPAT or JPAC physical agility test; physical examination.

MPC offers two Academies per calendar year. Each Academy is 22 weeks in length, one beginning in January and ending in June and the other beginning in July and ending in December.

Classes meet Saturday and Sunday from 5:30 am to 5pm (or longer), from 6pm – 10pm on Thursday. Students will be required to attend classes from 8am to 5pm for two full weeks for Rescue Systems 1 and Hazardous Materials First Responder Operational and Decontamination.

Costs: MPC tuition fees plus additional costs for the academy. Please call for details.
