FIRE 105 FIREFIGHTER 1 ACADEMY

17 UNITS

This course provides students with the State Fire Marshal's Office educational requirements for certification as a Firefighter1.

Prerequisites, EMMS 170; Biddle CPAT or JPAC physical agility test; physical examination.

Monterey Peninsula College (MPC) offers two Academies per calendar year. Each Academy is 20 weeks in length, one beginning in January and ending in May and the other beginning in July and ending in December.

Classes meet Saturday and Sunday from 5:30 am to 5pm (or longer), from 6pm – 10pm on Thursday. Students will be required to attend classes from 8am to 5pm for two full weeks for Rescue Systems 1 and Hazardous Materials First Responder Operational and Decontamination.

Cost: \$1,595 for the academy plus \$345* for 17 MPC units. (*Unit fees may increase in 2009.) Financial aid, if approved, will cover the MPC units only.

The next Firefighter Academy is scheduled for July 2009.

Applicant names are taken on a first come – first served basis.
