The purpose of this course is to provide students with the skills and knowledge needed to serve as public information officers (PIOF). The course covers establishing and maintaining an incident information operation, communicating with internal and external audiences, working with the news media, handling special situations, and long term planning and strategy.

With over 40 years of fire service experience, your instructor for S-203 - Intro to Incident Information (PIO) Greg Guyan is a retired CALFIRE Battalion Chief, Peace Officer, Instructor, Consultant and past President of the Board for a California Fire District. Throughout his career, BC Guyan has delivered public information at a myriad of all-risk emergency incidents, planned events, public meetings, with other agencies, stakeholders, small groups and one on one interaction with members of the public, media, business and governmental groups. His information interactions involved print, prerecorded & live radio, TV and social media networks and in person community information releases through local, regional and national media sources.
