This 1-day evaluator training will provide students with the information required to become a Registered Lead Evaluator or Skills Evaluator for the new Fire Fighter I certification examination process to be delivered by Accredited Regional Training Programs (ARTP) and Accredited Local Academies (ALA) on behalf of State Fire Training (SFT).

Prerequisites: Students must have an affiliation with an ARTP or ALA to be enrolled in this class. Additionally, students must, at a minimum meet the criteria set forth in the SFT Procedures Manual for Fire Fighter I instructor.
