Course provides local, state and federal-level emergency responders with a robust understanding of the duties, responsibilities, and capabilities of an effective Liaison Officer (LOFR) on an All-Hazards Incident Management Team (AHIMT). This is an instructor-led training that supports learning through discussion, lecture, and active participation in multiple exercises and provides a realistic, scenario-driven approach to mastering the skills required of a (LOFR). Exercises and discussions are based on lessons learned (LA City Airport Active Shooter, Thomas Fire, Woosley Fire) and other significant incidents/planned events, enabling participants to process and apply their new knowledge.

Prerequisites: ICS-100, ICS-200 Single Resource/Initial Action, ICS-300 Intermediate ICS for Expanding Incidents, ICS-400 Advanced ICS, 0700, 0800
