COURSE DESCRIPTION

Provides training for responders in environmental considerations, team organization, use of rope, knots, rigging and pulley systems, descending, rappelling and belaying tools and techniques, subsurface rescue techniques, use of shoring systems, cribbing, cutting/prying and hydraulic tools, use of fire service ladders in specialized rescue situations, and simulated rescue exercises.

PREREQUISITES

Low Angle Rope Rescue Operations (LARRO). MUST bring certificate to the first day of class.

REQUIREMENTS

PPE: Helmet, gloves, steel toe boots, eye/ear protection, pants and long sleeve shirt, sun block.

Manual: Students are required to download a copy of the State Fire Training Rescue Systems 1 manual from the SFT website: osfm.fire.ca.gov. Type "Rescue Systems 1" in the search box to get to the page where you can download the manual. Students may download either the paper or preferably the electronic version of the manual. All students MUST have a copy of the manual on the first day of class.
