# National Emergency Management Executive Academy (NEMEA) Overview / FY22 Application Process

The application window is April 1 - June 1, 2021, with selection announcements in August. Completed application packets will be reviewed by a formal selection committee.

#### National Emergency Management Advanced Academy (NEMAA)

#### **Program Description:**

The National Emergency Management Advanced Academy is a component of the Emergency Management Professional Program (EMPP) (https://training.fema.gov/empp/) NEMAA reinforces the qualities needed to lead emergency management programs, provides relevant management theories and concepts, and uses case studies to enhance emergency management (EM) skill sets. NEMAA participants work within a collaborative environment on projects and establish a network of peers.

NEMAA provides participants the opportunity to demonstrate their critical thinking ability through a guided NEMAA Paper. Students apply the key learning concepts from the NEMAA curriculum relative to their own strengths and weaknesses, their organizations, and their own performance environments.

NEMAA is designed for emergency management professionals with a minimum of five years' experience directly with an Emergency Management (EM) organization or five years' experience with a significant role directly connected to the Profession of Emergency Management or a recognized EM organization; to include, but are not limited to Public Health, Higher Education, Medical, and Private Sector organizations or companies with a role in Emergencies and Disasters.

#### Program Description:

The National Emergency Management Executive Academy is a component of the Emergency Management Professional Program (EMPP).

In collaboration with academia, renowned practitioners and industry leaders, the Emergency Management Institute (EMI) has created the National Emergency Management Executive Academy to produce a comprehensive and competency-based curriculum supporting the advancement of strategic and policy level executive leadership.

#### **Target Audience:**

The Executive Academy is designed for emergency management senior leaders in State, Local, Tribal, and Territorial governments; non-governmental organizations (NGOs), academic institutions, and private sector entities. Ideal candidates will serve in key senior leadership positions and are responsible for decisions that have a significant effect on emergency management policies.

The audience may include, but is not limited to:

Emergency management and homeland security directors or advisors leading in local, state, multijurisdictional, or large metropolitan areas;

Emergency management leaders from allied disciplines in the public sector, such as public utilities, K-12 education, higher education, public transportation, and military/DSCA roles; Administrators, such as members of the Governor's Cabinet or chief/director of an agency;

Federal administrators, at the Appointed or Senior Executive Service (SES)/GS15 level; and

Directors of voluntary organizations.

EMI will select up to 40 emergency management executives to participate in the Executive Academy per year. Each Cohort will reflect a Whole Community composition.

#### VILT Awareness Courses

AWR-333 Improvised Explosive Device Construction and Classification (IED-CC)

Provides foundational knowledge on the construction and classification of IEDs. [75 Min]

#### AWR-334 Introduction to the Terrorist Attack Cycle (ITAC)

Introduces a model of the terrorist attack cycle that describes the nature of terrorist surveillance, target selection, planning and other activities that occur before and immediately after an attack. [105 Min]

#### AWR-335 Response to Suspicious Behaviors and Items (RSBI)

Introduces the learner to the difference between normal and suspicious behaviors, physical characteristics that are not easily changeable and those that are, and the difference between unattended and suspicious items. Provides strategies and resources for responding to and reporting suspicious activities. [75 Min]

#### AWR-337 Improvised Explosive Device Explosive Effects Mitigation (IED-EEM)

Provide introductions to fundamentals of explosives effects. Details the difference between blast, thermal/incendiary, and fragmentation effects and describes the destructive consequences of each type of effect on a target. [75 Min]

#### AWR-338 Homemade Explosives Awareness and Precursor Awareness (HME-P)

Provides foundational knowledge on HMEs and common precursor materials used to build IEDs. [75 Min]


