The approximately 30-mile driving course will take you through terrain you will likely encounter while driving fire apparatus or vehicles off-road including steep inclines, descents, tight corners, narrow roads, and water crossings. The driving course emphasizes the capabilities and limits of apparatus and how to negotiate diverse types of terrain and obstacles safely. There will be a short morning class presentation with most of the day on the driving course.
