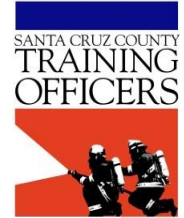

STRIKE TEAM/TASK FORCE LEADER, ALL HAZARDS

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course is designed to provide the skills and knowledge needed to perform in the position of Strike Team/Task Force Leader. Topics include position overview; pre-deployment responsibilities; concept of the position; resource typing standards; pre-dispatch preparation; incident responsibilities; administration; supervision; response; assignment; demobilization; tactics and safety; risk management; entrapment avoidance; wildland urban interface; all hazard case studies; scenarios; appropriate action vs. freelancing. The course concludes with a WUI structure defense scenario exercise.

- CICCIS qualified Engine Boss, Heavy Equipment Boss or Crew Boss
