Completion of the Advanced Professional Series (APS) certificate is an accomplishment that distinguishes emergency managers with substantial expertise in emergency operations and management. Completion of this series demonstrates extraordinary dedication to the goal of protecting lives, communities, and resources from disasters. The Clovis Fire Department will host the Emergency Management Institute's professional program, the National Emergency Management Advanced Academy (NEMAA). All courses for the Clovis Cohort offering will be held in the Fire Training/EOC Room, 1233 Fifth Street, Clovis, CA 93612.

Course Description The NEMAA is designed for current and emerging leaders in emergency management. Students learn skills critical to performing leadership responsibilities such as program management and oversight, effective communication at all levels, integrated collaboration, and strategic thinking.

The NEMAA provides students the opportunity to demonstrate their critical thinking ability through a guided 8-14 page paper. Students apply key learning concepts from the curriculum relative to their strengths, weaknesses, organization, and performance environments.

Target Audience: The NEMAA is designed for emergency management professionals with a minimum of five years' experience directly with an emergency management organization or five years' experience with a significant role directly connected to the profession of emergency management, such as public health, higher education, medical, and private sector organizations or companies with a role in emergencies and disasters.

Application deadline is close of business, August 31, 2021.

Application packages will be reviewed by a Cal OES/CSTI selection committee and require the following six items:

1. A General Admissions Application Form or **FEMA Form 119-25-1**, (Item 9.a. on the form should state "**E/L0451 National Emergency Management Advanced Academy**")
2. The applicant's signed **Advanced Academy Commitment Statement** indicating their commitment to complete the entire program to include the four courses and the NEMAA paper.
3. A **resume** not to exceed two (2) pages (no specific format is required).
4. A **cover letter** from the applicant (not to exceed one (1) page) requesting admission to the program and specifying the applicant's qualifications and perceived expectations of the program (no specific format is required).
5. An **Advanced and Executive Academy Questionnaire**.
6. A **Letter of Recommendation** from the applicant's Supervisor.

NOTE: Cover letters and two-page resumes are not of any required format; however, the most successful applicants will use those two documents to address how they meet the Applicant Selection Criteria below.

Applications evaluated based on recommended prerequisites to include:

- A minimum of five (5) years in an emergency management position
- Project and group emergency management commitment and leadership
- Substantial continuing service and commitment to the field of emergency management
- Whole community representation

AWR-334 Introduction to the Terrorist Attack Cycle (ITAC) Introduces a model of the terrorist attack cycle that describes the nature of terrorist surveillance, target selection, planning and other activities that occur before and immediately after an attack. [105 Min]
AWR-335 Response to Suspicious Behaviors and Items (RSBI) Introduces the learner to the difference between normal and suspicious behaviors, physical characteristics that are not easily changeable and those that are, and the difference between unattended and suspicious items. Provides strategies and resources for responding to and reporting suspicious activities. [75 Min]
AWR-337 Improvised Explosive Device Explosive Effects Mitigation (IED-EEM) Provide introductions to fundamentals of explosives effects. Details the difference between blast, thermal/incendiary, and fragmentation effects and describes the destructive consequences of each type of effect on a target. [75 Min]
AWR-338 Homemade Explosives Awareness and Precursor Awareness (HME-P) Provides foundational knowledge on HMEs and common precursor materials used to build IEDs. [75 Min]
