IEMCs are exercise-based training workshops that place a jurisdiction's Emergency Operations Center (EOC) personnel in realistic crisis situations within a structured learning environment. The jurisdiction selects the hazard(s) and the Core Capabilities it wishes to include in both the plenary and exercise components of the course to reflect the jurisdiction's hazards or events, EOC type, and organizations included in emergency plans. Data reported in the applicable Stakeholder Preparedness Report and the Threat and Hazard Identification and Risk Assessment should be used as a basis for the request.</p> <p>A community-specific IEMC builds awareness and skills needed to develop/refine and implement a jurisdiction's policies, plans, procedures, and mutual aid agreements in an EOC environment. Skilled EMI curriculum and exercise specialists conduct extensive virtual planning with jurisdictional staff to collect local information, identify critical infrastructure, study transportation systems, and analyze current response plans. From this information, exercises are built to access the jurisdiction's planned approach to specific hazards and to surface issues that IEMC participants may need to reevaluate and develop corrective action plans.</p> <p>Target Audience: IEMCs are Homeland Security Exercise and Evaluation Program (HSEEP) consistent and designed for personnel who fill specific emergency support positions within their community. A sample of appropriate attendees include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Chief elected and appointed officials from local, regional, State, and Federal emergency management agencies; • Senior-level personnel from response agencies and organizations (e.g., law enforcement, fire, emergency medical services, and public health); • Managers from Volunteer Organizations Active in Disasters (VOADs); and, • Representatives from private organizations which participate in local, regional, and State responses. <p>For a complete list of recommended attendees, refer to the IEMC website (http://training.fema.gov/iemc/iemcpos.aspx).</p>

VILT Awareness Courses
AWR-333 Improvised Explosive Device Construction and Classification (IED-CC) Provides foundational knowledge on the construction and classification of IEDs. [75 Min]
AWR-334 Introduction to the Terrorist Attack Cycle (ITAC) Introduces a model of the terrorist attack cycle that describes the nature of terrorist surveillance, target selection, planning and other activities that occur before and immediately after an attack. [105 Min]
AWR-335 Response to Suspicious Behaviors and Items (RSBI) Introduces the learner to the difference between normal and suspicious behaviors, physical characteristics that are not easily changeable and those that are, and the difference between unattended and suspicious items. Provides strategies and resources for responding to and reporting suspicious activities. [75 Min]
AWR-337 Improvised Explosive Device Explosive Effects Mitigation (IED-EEM) Provide introductions to fundamentals of explosives effects. Details the difference between blast, thermal/incendiary, and fragmentation effects and describes the destructive consequences of each type of effect on a target. [75 Min]
AWR-338 Homemade Explosives Awareness and Precursor Awareness (HME-P) Provides foundational knowledge on HMEs and common precursor materials used to build IEDs. [75 Min]
AWR-340 Protective Measures Awareness (PMA) Provides an overview of the risk management process, surveillance detection and the development of appropriate protective measures on facility characteristics. [75 Min]
