## Fire Apparatus Driver/Operator 1A Pumping Apparatus Driver/Operator 1B

D/O 1A provides the knowledge and skills needed to perform preventive maintenance on and drive or operate a fire apparatus. Topics include routine tests, inspections, and servicing functions; operating, backing, maneuvering, and turning a fire apparatus under a variety of conditions; and operating all fixed systems and equipment on a fire apparatus. Fulfills the requirements for a Class C driver's license fire fighter endorsement. D/O 1A is a required prerequisite for D/O 1B.

D/O 1B provides the knowledge and skills needed to operate and perform preventative maintenance on a pumping apparatus. Topics include routine tests, inspections, and servicing functions; producing hand, master, and foam fire streams; relay pump operations; and supplying water to fire sprinkler and standpipe systems.

#### D/O 1B - 40 hours

May 5, 1600 – 2000; May 6 & 7, 0900 - 1700 each day  
May 19, 1600 – 2000; May 20 & 21, 0900 - 1700 each day

Attendance on all days is mandatory. There will be no provision for make-up. Per State Fire Training guidelines, a student who misses more than 10% of the required course attendance hours will not receive credit for the course.
