Description:	This course provides the knowledge and skills to prepare an emergency responder to extricate victim(s) from a common passenger vehicle in a safe and effective manner in accordance with AHJ policies and procedures. Topics include sizing up an incident; creating an incident action plan; establishing safety zones; mitigating hazards; stabilizing and creating access and egress openings for rescue from a vehicle resting on its wheels, side, and roof or in a multi-hazard configuration or environment; disentangling and removing victims; and terminating an incident. This course incorporates awareness, operations, and technician training based on NFPA 1006 (2021).

Pre-requisites:	: IS-100, IS-200, IS-700, IS-800 (FEMA – online) Public Safety-First Aid (CA Health and Safety Code 1979.182) CPR (CA Health and Safety Code 1979.182)
