By the end of this three-day, 24-hour course, students will be able to demonstrate, through activities and a Final Exam, the duties, responsibilities, and capabilities of an effective Finance/Administration Section Chief on an All-Hazards incident. This class meets CICCS requirements for fire service personnel.
