Residential Fire Sprinkler Systems National Fire Protection Associations 13D Standard, 2022 Edition

Course Description: This class is based on the 2022 Edition of NFPA Standard 13D. The class will go over the general review process from permit application to final approval. Changes to the upcoming edition will be mentioned if available. During the process we will focus on the critical path starting from the water purveyors to a three dimensional viewpoint while reviewing plans. The Inspections process involves a review of the minimum code requirements and understanding the core issues required in having a functional system prior to occupancy. Plan checkers, inspectors, architects and contractors will gain valuable knowledge in understanding the entire approval process from start to finish. More importantly, you will learn to ask questions upon returning to your jurisdiction.

Objectives: Upon completion participants will better be able to:

1. Better understand the importance of water pressure and pipe sizes.
2. Understand what information is necessary for a complete permit submittal.
3. Understand key points needed for a proper plan review.
4. Understand the basic information to conduct an inspection prior to occupancy.
