AWR-335 Response to Suspicious Behaviors and Items (RSBI) Introduces the learner to the difference between normal and suspicious behaviors, physical characteristics that are not easily changeable and those that are, and the difference between unattended and suspicious items. AWR-337 Improvised Explosive Device Explosive Effects Mitigation (IED-EEM) Provide introductions to fundamentals of explosives effects.
