- Description:** This course is designed to prepare the student for utilizing topographic maps for wildland firefighting and technical search and rescue. The course covers: Topographic map reading, rectangular land description system, latitude and longitude identification, UTM, map symbology, cartography, bearing and triangulation, intro to GPS, AVENZA, and field exercise. This course follows NWCG PMS 475 and Map and Compass curriculum, and is an ideal starting point for students preparing to be a Single Resource Boss, including Field Observer/Display processor, Fireline EMT etc.
